Danville Academy fonds. - [1863?]-[1876?]. - 0.02 m of textual records.

Administrative history:

The first school was established in Danville in 1817. Following enlargement and reorganization in 1854, it was named the Danville Academy. Managed during the 19th century by a three-member board of trustees, this non-sectarian school lasted until the Asbestos-Danville-Shipton High School was opened in 1951. In the 1950s, the building was sold to the Catholic Church and converted into a Carmelite convent. Carmel de Belle-Croix.

Scope and content:

The fonds contains source material on the operations, curriculum and students of Danville Academy from 1860 to 1880. It consists of a calendar for the 1863-1864 school year, and a grade book possibly covering the period of 1864 to 1876. Newspaper clippings are glued into the grade book.

Notes:



St. Helen's School fonds. - 1879-1971. - 0.31 m of textual records

Administrative history:

The founding of St. Helen's School (as Dunham Ladies' College), by the Reverend Ashton Oxenden, Bishop of the Diocese of Montreal of the Church of England, dates to 1875, though it did not open its doors until 1878. Administered by a corporation composed of clergymen and lay people, Dunham Ladies' College encountered many financial problems and had to close from 1885 to 1888 and from 1890 to 1894. In 1913, with the College still facing financial difficulties, the Corporation leased it to the then principal, Miss Wade, at her request. Now under the management of a board of governors, Dunham Ladies' College was renamed St. Helen's School. In 1972, St. Helen's School was closed down after almost a century of existence.

Scope and content:

The fonds contains source material on the operations, organization, students, and curriculum of Dunham Ladies' College and St. Helen's School from 1879 to 1971. It consists mostly of material from the Dunham Ladies' College period. It is comprised of the following series: Constitution and By-laws (1906), Annual Reports (1898-1971), Accounting registers (1900-1918), School Registers (1894-1910), List of Results at the June Exams (1897-1909), Provincial Statistics on the June Exams (1904-1909), Calendars (1879-1964) and Miscellaneous Documents (1879-[1956?]).

Notes:

Previously known as Dunham Ladies' College Papers.

Title based on contents of fonds.

The documents were donated in 1977 by Alan W. Jones, a professor in the Faculty of Education of Bishop's University. The documents had file marks. These were disregarded in order to respect classification system used for other fonds. The documents are in English.

No more accruals are expected.







King's Hall fonds. - 1914-1965. - 0.45 m of textual records.

Administrative history:

Compton Ladies' College was founded by the reverend Joseph Dinzey in 1874. A girls' school, the College was managed by a corporation composed of the Bishop of the Diocese of Quebec of the Church of England and four other members appointed by the Synod of the Diocese. In 1884, the College closed because of financial difficulties. It reopened in 1886 under the administration of Reverend George Herbert Parker and a new corporation presided over by the Bishop of Quebec. In 1902, Gena Smith, then Headmistress, reorganized the school on the model of British ladies' schools and had its name changed to King's Hall to mark the coronation of King Edward VII of England, which took place on the 9th of August of that year. A new corporation, formed of the Bishop of Quebec and twelve other members, was established. Through the years, King's Hall expanded its buildings and modified its philosophy of education to suit the needs of a modern educational institution. Girls from different countries and across Canada attended. King's Hall closed its doors in 1972. Students were transferred to Bishop's College School in Lennoxville, until that time a male institution.

Custodial history:

The documents now in the fonds were kept by Colonel Norman H. Welsh, Bursar of Bishop's University from 1963 to 1968 and Honorary Treasurer of King's Hall from 1962 to 1968. When Colonel Welsh died in 1968, they were left at Bishop's University. They were transferred to the Archives in 1984.

Scope and content:

The fonds contains source material on King's Hall's financial situation, operations, property, and employee working conditions from 1914 to 1965. The fonds consists of documents relating to finances and accounting. The fonds is comprised of the following series: Constitution and By-laws (1929). Minutes (1962-1963). Reports and Financial Statements (1914-1961). Personnel (1952-1964). Accounting Documents (1936-1964), Income (1938-1965), Insurance ([195-?]-[196-?]), Fees (1940-1961), Provincial Legislation (1961) and Miscellaneous Documents (1935-1964).

Eastern Townships Association of Teachers fonds (Appalachian Teachers' Association: Bedford Association of Teachers). - 1966-2000. - 5.25 m of textual records. - 1 photograph.

Administrative history:

The Eastern Townships Association of Teachers was founded in Lennoxville in 1966. The Association's mandate is to protect the professional, economic, and social interests of its members, namely teachers in the Protestant schools of the Eastern Townships. Four local teachers' organizations (Compton County Protestant Teachers, Richmond-Drummond-Arthabaska Protestant Teachers, Sherbrooke County Protestant Teachers, and Stanstead County Protestant Teachers) merged in January 1966 to form the new association, which was recognized under the Labour Code and incorporated under the Professional Syndicates Act. The Association is run by an executive committee, the number of whose members varies, and various committees responsible for such matters as nominating, negotiating, professional improvement, educational policy and classification. Each school in the region names a shop steward. Delegates also sit on the Board of Directors of the Provincial Association of Protestant Teachers.

Scope and content:
